

## Oily Waste Cans

Good housekeeping is essential to fire safety. Waste cans should be provided at convenient locations to help minimize the hazard of oil- or solvent-soaked wiping cloths, rags or waste. At the end of each normal working period, these containers should be emptied and the accumulated waste burned in the plant incinerator or moved to a safe location.

These cans are made of sheet metal with self-closing, tightly fitting covers. When paint- or solvent-saturated waste is placed in them, any fire which starts from spontaneous ignition or other cause is confined within the can. The bottom of the can is raised so that heat from a fire in the can will not ignite a wooden floor or other combustibles under it.
